## About this course:

- This course is suitable for beginners and those that have experience with no formal training.
- It is designed to provide and confirm the skills and knowledge to enter and work in confined spaces.
- PCBU's (employers and those responsible) need to ensure that they have provided training
  to ensure that hazards and risks are managed effectively. This course imparts the basic skills
  and knowledge required and does not replace Site Specific Inductions and Task Inductions.
- This involves moderate physical activity including climbing up and down ladders, putting on a harness, being at heights and entering confined spaces.
- The course commences once booked! The nominal time for this course is up to 20 hours. As
  a guide, you will need to spend up to 4 hours reading and completing your Student
  Workbook, followed by one full day of attendance to complete the minimum requirements.

  further information. You must have a good comprehension of the English Language to
  undertake this course as it requires pre-attendance reading and a Student Workbook to be
