

TRAFFIC CONTROLLER RENEWAL COURSE STUDENT JOURNEY

The renewal course requires:

- Current or recently expired card
- Currency of Industry Practice (COIP) for a minimum of 32 hours stop-slow duties in the last 12 months.

1. Enrol in your Course

Book your course online or by calling our friendly customer service team.

2. Pre-course Requirement

Prepare your Currency of Industry Practice (COIP) prior to attending your course. You must have a minimum of 32 hours stop/slow duties in the last 12 months.

3. Attend 1 Day of Training

You will receive 1 day of training involving theory & practical. Your assessor will verify your COIP submission.

4. Receive your Credentials

After attending the course and you have been deemed competent, you will receive a Statement of Attainment for the following units:



RIICOM201E Communicate in the workplace

RIIWHS201E Work safely and follow WHS policy and procedure

RIIWHS205E Control traffic with a stop-slow bat

5. Apply for your TC Renewal Card

Once you have received your Statement of Attainment, you must take this to the Department of Transport and Main Roads and lodge your renewal application.
